

Geography Practice

When possible, the Roadmap provides users with useful links from the Internet that will help students review content. Lizardpoint is a web-site that supplies several excellent geography practice quizzes. The games are simple: the site provides a location and the students click on the map to guess the correct location. Three attempts are allowed per each question.

The links below are particularly constructive for the study of U.S. History:

1. Test Your Geography: [The USA quiz](#) quizzes students on the location of the 50 states.
2. Test Your Geography: [The USA State Capital Quiz](#) quizzes students on the location of all 50 state capitals.
3. Test Your Geography: [The USA Major Cities Quiz](#) quizzes students on the location of 158 major US cities.

To make use of this program as effectively as possible, it is recommended that students keep track of their own progress each time they complete a quiz. Three points is provided for each correct first guess, two points if a location is successfully located on the second try, and one point if found on the third attempt. At the end of the test, a student will have a point score that can be recorded to represent his/her achievement on the test. However, multiple attempts will certainly increase a student's score and it is highly recommended that a student both takes the test multiple times and over some sort of prescribed time period. For example, three times a week for a month.
